Job title: Food Sorting Volunteer

Purpose/objective:

The London Good Food Box is a neighbourhood based food distribution system that provides a variety of seasonal delicious, and nutritious vegetables and fruits at an affordable price. The London Good Food Box is committed to creating socially, and economically sustainable neighborhoods.

The food sorting volunteer will work with others to sort through the monthly food shipment and assemble the orders in preparation for distribution the following day.

Benefits:

The volunteer will develop or enhance their warehouse management skills while meeting new people and ensure all Londoners have access to fresh affordable produce.

Location:

Sorting will take place at Glen Cairn Community Resource Centre which is located at 244 Adelaide St S.

Key responsibilities:

- Inspecting produce to ensure it meets quality standards
- Assembling cardboard boxes
- Packing produce in each box, ensuring continuity across the board
- Reviewing orders and ensuring every box is packed

Qualifications:

- Must be able to stand for long periods of time
- Must be able to lift 50 pounds

Time commitment:

Two to three hours once a month

Training/support provided:

- Glen Cairn Community Resource Centre orientation
- Good Food Box training
